Seed Mixes

Use drought tolerant species such as Creeping Red Fescue, Tall Fescue and Ryegrass. Kentucky bluegrass has a short root system and requires more nutrients and water for vigour, so no more than 10% Kentucky blue grass is recommended. If you can find some with at least 5% clover all the better as clover fixes atmospheric nitrogen to the soil and naturally feeds the grass.

Adding Nutrients

The lake friendly maintenance practices in combination with the use of fescue-based seed mixes and clover will provide a long-term low maintenance turf that does not need the addition of any fertilizer. For turf repairs or boosting areas of poor establishment, consider organic composts.

Home Compost Bin or Pile: Ideally, nutrients already in the watershed should be used. A mix of brown (leaves, etc) plus greens (from the kitchen) make the best compost. A page on composting will be developed to help ensure that proper composting is achieved.

Commercial Compost: compost can be obtained in bags or in bulk from a number of landscape supplies. Ask for non-manure or vegetable-based compost.
