Please record the maximum number of any one creature that you see at one time (e.g. if you look out and see 3 chickadees the first time, the next time 7 and the next 5- the number you would submit is 7). The results will be tallied and posted on the PLWA website. No personal information will be shared.

PLWA hopes to raise awareness of the wildlife that shares our lake and surrounding watershed area. Please join us in this endeavour while you enjoy the holidays at the lake.

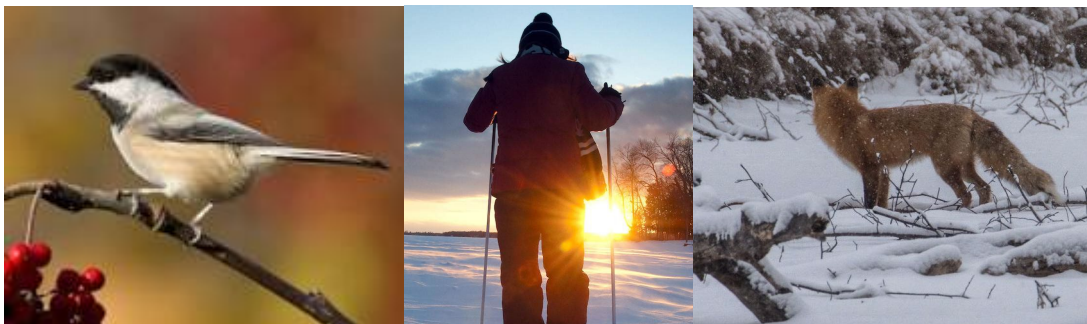
